



# Carving Instructions

1. Carve a circular opening from the bottom of your pumpkin. Clean out the seeds and strings with the Scraper Scoop™. Scrape inner pulp away from the area you plan to carve until the pumpkin inner wall is about **1" thick**.
2. Wet the pattern.
3. Apply it to the pumpkin while wet. Get it as smooth as possible.
4. While it's still wet, cover the pattern with plastic cling wrap, overlapping all the edges, and smooth it down.
5. Hold the pumpkin in your lap. Saw at a 90° angle to the pumpkin with gentle pressure. The saw is breakable if used incorrectly.  
If the pattern becomes fragile or ragged as you carve, patch over it with more plastic wrap, and continue carving. Make the outermost cuts last.
6. Place your carved pumpkin over a battery-operated light.\*  
Watch your carving come to life!
